TENDER FOR MRT UNDERGROUND STATION RETAIL SPACES

Kuala Lumpur, 21 February 2017: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) wishes to announce that the tender for retail spaces in the MRT underground stations of the MRT Sungai Buloh-Kajang (SBK) Line will commence tomorrow, 22 February 2017.

The request for proposal document will be on sale after the briefing session. The price of the document is RM212.00 and shall only be payable by banker's cheque or bank draft.



MRT Corp Director of Commercial and Land Management Dato' Haris Fadzilah Hassan said MRT Corp welcomed businesses registered with the Companies Commission of Malaysia (SSM) to participate in the tender.

"Potential applicants will need to have a minimum capital paid-up of RM500,000.00 and a minimum of three years' experience in their proposed business," he said.

He said the retail space at the three underground stations, ranging from about 77 square metres to about 122 square metres, were bigger than those at the elevated stations.

"I believe the location of the stations, and the number of commuters expected to be using the SBK Line when the entire line opens, will provide endless opportunities to the successful retailers," said Haris.

MRT Corp was looking for retailers with exciting business ideas and services that were suitable for commuters with fast-paced mobility and urban lifestyles, he added.

The successful applicant will be selected based on the best evaluated proposal and MRT Corp reserves the right not to accept the highest bidder, he said.
