MRT CORP AWARDS STATION WORK PACKAGE TO IJM

Kuala Lumpur, 15 June 2017: Mass Rapid Transit Corporation Sdn Bhd (MRT Corp) wishes to announce the award of a contract for the construction of stations for the MRT Sungai Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya (SSP) Line.

Work Package S203 for the construction and completion of elevated stations and other associated works at Sri Delima, Kampung Batu, Kentonmen and half-sunken station at Jalan Ipoh was awarded to IJM Construction Sdn Bhd.

The contract sum is RM342.18 million.

The award was made after a meeting by the One Stop Procurement Committee chaired by Finance Minister Dato' Sri Mohd Najib Tun Abdul Razak.

The tender for Work Package S203, which is in the open category, commenced on 29 November 2016 and ended on 20 February 2017. A total of seven companies had submitted tenders for this Work Package.

IJM Construction is also the work package contractor for V203 for the construction of the elevated guideway and other associated works from Jinjang to the Jalan Ipoh North Escape Shaft. The four stations that IJM Construction will be building under the newly awarded contract are located along this stretch of alignment.

Previously, IJM Construction had been awarded two contracts under the MRT Sungai Buloh – Kajang (SBK) Line, which are the construction and completion of the viaduct guideway and other associated works from the Maluri Portal to the Taman Connaught Station (Elevated Section V5), as well as the construction and completion of elevated stations and other associated works at Taman Pertama, Taman Midah, Taman Mutiara and Taman Connaught (Package S5).

MRT Corp Chief Executive Officer Dato' Sri Shahril Mokhtar congratulated IJM Construction Sdn Bhd and welcomed the fact that they were already very familiar with the Klang Valley MRT Project.



"IJM Construction has a lot of experience working on the MRT Project and this will be invaluable as they proceed with working on this newest contract. I believe they will maintain their very good track record with our project and will give their best to perform well for the SSP Line Project," he said.

Shahril added that IJM was selected on the basis of Best Evaluated Tender, where the tenders were evaluated on their technical, commercial, legal and financial evaluation.

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
