near former Desa Water Park**

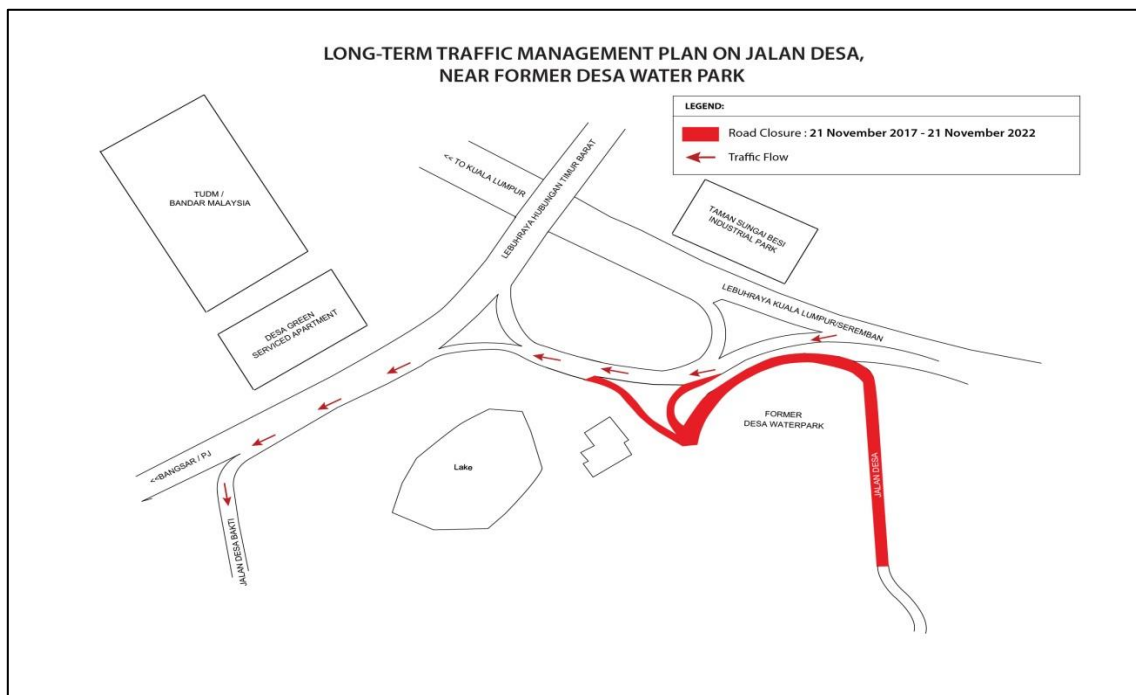

KUALA LUMPUR, 17 November 2017: MMC Gamuda KVMRT (T) Sdn Bhd (MGKT) wishes to announce the implementation of a long-term traffic management plan involving the closure of Jalan Desa, near the former Desa Water Park, beginning **21 November 2017 until 21 November 2022**.

The closure will affect the traffic coming from KL-Seremban Highway heading to Taman Desa via Jalan Desa at the former Desa Water Park.

With the new traffic management plan, motorists will now use Jalan Desa Bakti via Lebuhraya Timur-Barat (East-West Link Highway). The Traffic Management Plan has been approved and gazetted by Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL).

The closure, affecting 1.7 km stretch of Jalan Desa is critical to facilitate the construction of the South Portal for the Sungai Buloh-Serdang-Putrajaya (SSP) MRT Project. Following this closure, the alternative road to access Taman Desa is via Jalan Desa Bakti. Please see map below on the location of the closure.



Motorists are advised to follow the directional signage and during the closure, the MRT Project Emergency Response Team will be deployed to help direct traffic. MGKT wishes to apologise for the inconvenience caused.
